BELIEVE CAMPAIGN

In March 2018 we began an initiative called "BELIEVE - In Him | For Them". The vision was to renovate much of our campus... with minimal or no debt.

The areas to be renovated were:

- The Shalom Center for Adults and Senior Adults (previously the 83 Building and Game Room)
- Preschool Ministry Space (Building 4 Upper Level)
- Elementary Space (Building 5 Upper Level)
- Student Ministry Space (Building 5 Lower Level)

The total projected cost was \$2,500,000

We are excited to tell you that all of the renovations are complete. That is indeed something to celebrate.

The original amount pledged to the Believe Campaign was \$1,938,799.

During 2019 - \$665,554.08 was donated to the Believe Campaign. The total received as of August 31, 2019 was \$1,486,634.

Although the physical projects are complete, we have not fully paid for all of the renovations.
