REOPENING PLAN

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - KIDS MINISTRY

Will people be wearing masks? Does my child need a mask?

All volunteers will be wearing masks, but they are not required for kids. We will have some additional masks available, and kids are welcome to wear a mask if they are comfortable doing so.

How many kids will be in a room?

There will be no more than ten kids per room.

What are the NEW check-in and pick-up procedures for kids (Birth – 5th Grade)?

1. The kids areas will have one-way traffic (using feet on the ground as mapping).

2. Only one adult will be checking kids in.

3. Drop kids off at main doors in both lobby areas. We are requesting that there are no parents in kids areas to minimize the total number of people in our hallway areas.

4. Elementary pick-up will be at the fire door at the end of the Elementary hall.

5. For Preschool pick-up, locations will be split. Last names beginning with A-L will pickup in the Main Preschool Lobby. Last names beginning with M-Z will pick-up at the Elementary Lobby door.

6. All kids will be required to wash their hands upon entering and exiting their classrooms.

7. Check-in stations will have an attendant to check kids in to eliminate unnecessary touch points along the way.

Will there be physical distancing?

Yes. We will do our very best, but as you know, it's very hard to keep kids distanced from each other. We will have seating strategically placed in the classroom to help with the process.

How will the kids spaces be sanitized?

The process for the restrooms is to follow each "use" with an application of misting spray of PH7Q (8-10 seconds activation time on faucets, handles, seats, and sinks), then wipe down surfaces with disposable towels. All classroom bathrooms will be locked and will only use the hallway to guarantee cleaning is done each time of use.

What will kids' interactions look like during the programs?

Kids' interactions will be a condensed lesson in the classroom with their teachers. They will involve a large group lesson and an activity for each individual. In most groups, we will remove tables and chairs and will sit on floors. Each child will have their own supply kit in a bag that includes scissors, crayons, pencil, and any other necessary supplies. They will use this same bag 9with their name on it) weekly.

Note: There will be NO large group meeting at this time.

Will you continue to provide resources online?

Yes. Our Kids Ministry will continue to provide online resources until we are fully back in operation.

Will you serve food or snacks?

We will not be serving food or snacks for the Kids Ministry at this time.

Will you be screening people for COVID-19 before they participate in the programming?

We will ask all parents to check temperatures before bringing their kids to church. Our volunteers will check their own temperatures each morning.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – STUDENT MINISTRY

Will people be wearing masks? Does my student need a mask?

Some of our students will be wearing a mask, some will not. They do not have to wear a mask to attend.

How many students will be in a room?

During Phase 1, the students will be outside, and we are working on the number for how many can fit safely in a classroom when we resume ministry indoors.

What are the check-in/pick-up procedures?

We are asking that students show up right before programming starts and leave right when it ends.

Will there be physical distancing?

Yes.

How will the student spaces be sanitized?

With some really cool cleaning products. We will be cleaning the bathrooms, Student Worship Space, and classrooms after every use. The process for the restrooms is to follow each "use" with an application of misting spray of PH7Q (8-10 seconds activation time on faucets, handles, seats, and sinks).

What will student interactions look like during the programs?

We are asking the students to maintain six-foot distancing at this time.

Will you continue to provide resources online?

Yes, we will continue to provide an online experience.

Will you serve food or snacks? The Jersey Students Coffee Shop will be closed and we will not be serving any snacks at this time.
